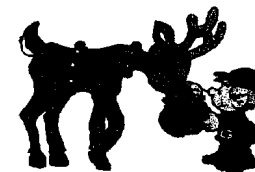

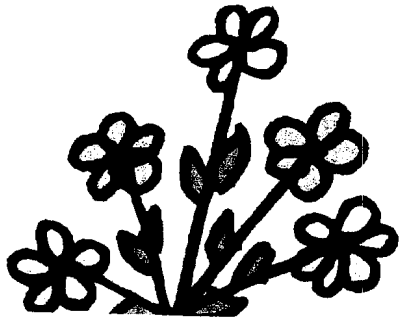


The Society aims to help, guide, instruct and inform those who are interested in horticulture.

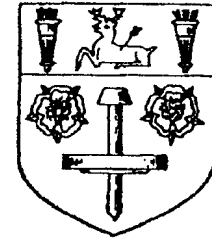
Membership fees are due in January each year

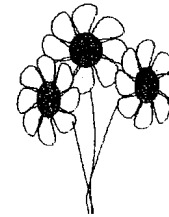
